

SUPPORTING SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN ALBANIA DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC!

The Center for Legal Civic Initiatives (CLCI) is providing support for survivors of domestic violence in Albania, which has been made possible by the urgent response grant for domestic violence service providers during the COVID-19 crisis thanks to the support of Oak Foundation.

Within the framework of this project, survivors of domestic violence benefited from free legal aid and support in the form of food packages, hygienic packages, medication, as well as free and safe transport to the shelters for abused women and girls or institutions such as court, prosecutor's office, etc.

Who was supported during the period of September to November 2020?

During the period of September to November 2020, CLCI supported 49 women and girls affected by violence with free legal aid and other support. During December the number of beneficiaries, victims of domestic violence is more than 60.
